

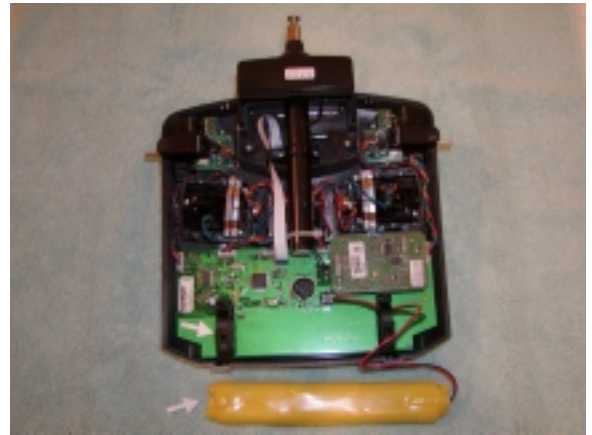
BECKER ANTENNA INSTALLATION FOR THE ROYAL EVO

- 1. Remove the back cover of Royal Evo:**
Slide the two latch buttons down, tilting the top of the back cover toward you a couple inches, and then lifting the back cover away from the unit.

NOTE: The electronic components inside the Royal Evo are static-sensitive. Make sure to ground yourself before proceeding further.



- 2. Remove the battery pack:**
Unlatch the two black "keepers". The battery pack can remain plugged-in, just removed from the inside of the unit.



- 3. Remove the antenna from the tube:**
Make sure the Royal Evo antenna is collapsed and in the most vertical position. Then, carefully and firmly, push the antenna from the top. The antenna will slide out from the bottom of the antenna tube so you might want to place a finger over the end of the tube.

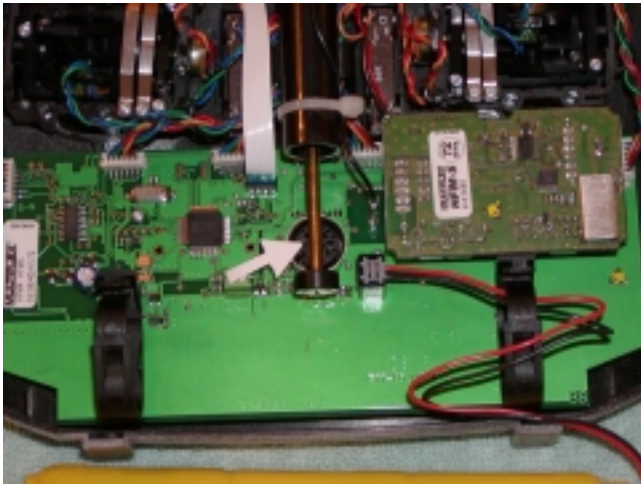


- 4. Prepare antenna for installation:**
Remove the long screw, with ferrule, from the metal adapter supplied with the antenna.



5. Install the antenna adapter:

Insert the long screw, with ferrule, into the antenna tube from the bottom of the tube. Insert a long flat-blade screwdriver into the slot in the screw and push the screw up to the top of the antenna tube. (Inserting the screwdriver in the screw slot before sliding the screw to the top of the antenna tube may be easier than trying to blindly find the screw slot later.)



Now, insert the smaller diameter end of the adapter into the top of the antenna tube until it contacts the screw. Holding the screw from turning with the screwdriver, turn the adapter clockwise to screw it onto the screw. Tighten the screw to the adapter snugly and remove the screwdriver from the antenna tube.

8. Install the Becker Antenna:

Simply insert the antenna into the top of the adapter and screw in snugly. You may need to hold the part of the adapter extending out of the top of the Evo as you screw in the antenna.
